The Austhos Travelling Fellowship

The Austhos Travelling Fellowship is a \$5000 Fellowship which will be awarded during Austin Health Research Week. To be eligible for the Fellowship, applicants must have submitted an abstract for Austin Health Research Week.

Aim

The aim of the Fellowship is to encourage a young researcher to further his/her research career by enabling attendance at an international scientific meeting or work experience in an overseas laboratory.

Award

The Fellowship will include an economy class air fare and one week's accommodation (negotiable) to attend an international scientific meeting or an overseas laboratory.

(Total Value: Up to \$5000)

Selection Criteria

- Young researcher (preferably under 40 years of age)
- Quality of abstract submitted for Research Week
- Excellence of research record
- Demonstrated ongoing commitment to research
- Reports will be sought from supervisors.

Austin Health Research Week Committee.
